Cork Eucharistic Procession 100 years



The Diocese of Cork and Ross is preparing for a very special and historic celebration as we commemorate the centenary of the first Eucharistic Procession in Cork on Sunday 7th June 2026.

To mark this special occasion we as a family of parishes will take part this year and walk in the procession. To make it easy for everyone we will have a bus leaving at lunchtime on Sunday June 7th leaving from Carrigaline Church at 1.15pm to the Cathedral and returning after the procession approx 5pm from the Imperial Hotel.

Anybody who would like to go on this bus drop your name into the sacristy or pop into the parish office during the week. The good news is there will be no charge for the bus.

If you would like to make your own way there you can of course join up with us at the North Cathedral prior to the Procession Start time of 3pm.

Relics of St Carlo Acutis and Eucharistic Adoration

The Relics of St Carlo Acutis are coming to Cork for our 100 year Eucharistic Procession Programme.

Between Friday 29th May and Monday 1st June there will be Veneration of the Relics, Prayer, Masses, Eucharistic adoration and Special Talks daily in either the North Cathedral or St Peter & Pauls Church.
